CHIN UP-DATE

We have added a new relationship with Acts 29, a church planting organization. Bob is going through their process to be able to coordinate and coach their church planters. In the next couple of months he will take on mentoring 2-4 church planters for them.

Bob is working on an invitation to Uganda, tentatively planned for 9/09. He has been asked to come help in the areas of leadership development, church planting and conflict resolution. He is trying to put a team together. This is short notice, and we are in prayer for the Lord to bring the team together and provide the necessary funding.

Light of the Nations, in Denver, Colorado, is a church plant Bob has been mentoring. They are getting close to their launch date under the leadership of Andy Millar. They have been gathering a core group and developing leadership. The uniqueness of this ministry is that they are

planting a first generation multi-ethnic church. They are reaching Hindus and Muslims who have recently immigrated here. These people are from India, Iraq and Bhutan. Light of the Nations is building bridges and making solid relationships in the Denver area. Please be in prayer for the leadership as well as Andy and his wife, Donna. Bob will be traveling to Denver again in June.

Here in Seattle, one of the ministries Bob is working with is a small, young ministry. He is helping in strategic planning and leadership development. At a recent outreach event, 10 people responded to the gospel invitation and received Jesus into their lives. Members of the church produced a movie series that was shown at the event. Many invited friends, and some came because of You-Tube and Face book. The group is praying for a full-time pastor and desire to continue growing personally.

We wanted to give you expanded information on these ministries so that you can continue to pray and know the prayer needs. We will try to highlight specifics on various ministries in each issue.

Additional note: There is preliminary planning for a trip to Nepal in spring 2010.
